Excellency,

Further to my letters dated 11 February and 12 March 2019 regarding the high-level plenary meeting of the General Assembly to commemorate the one-hundredth anniversary of the establishment of the International Labour Organization (ILO) and interactive dialogue on future of work, pursuant to resolution A/RES/73/282, I have the honour to inform you that there is a high number of inscriptions of delegations in the list of speakers for the commemorative plenary meeting.

In order to accommodate the requests of Member States and observers to speak at the High-level meeting, I intend to extend the commemorative plenary segment of the high-level meeting to Thursday, 11 April 2019. In this regard, the opening segment will take place on Wednesday, 10 April 2019, from 10.00 a.m. in the General Assembly Hall, followed by the commemorative plenary meeting from 10.50 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. The commemorative plenary meeting will then continue on Thursday, 11 April 2019, at 10.00 a.m. in the General Assembly Hall. The closing segment will also take place in the General Assembly Hall once the list of speakers has been exhausted. Kindly note that the time limit for statements will be three minutes for individual delegations and five minutes for statements made on behalf of a group of States.

Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 73/282, a youth representative will speak at the meeting. In this regard, I have the honour to inform you that Ms. Jolly Amatyia, representative from the Major Group on Children and Youth, has been selected to address the General Assembly on this occasion. It is also my intention to invite H.E. Ms. Inga Rhonda King, President of the Economic and Social Council, to also address the General Assembly.
