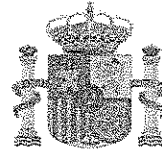

Excellency,

We write to you in our capacity as co-facilitators to the intergovernmental consultations and negotiations to determine the precise modalities and organizational aspects of the International Migration Review Forum (IMRF) and articulate how the contributions of the regional review and other relevant process will inform the Forums, as means to strengthen the overall effectiveness and the consistency of the follow-up and review outlined in the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration. Paragraph-49 of the same Compact further envisioned IMRF as a global platform where Member States would be able to review its implementation progress and guide the direction of the United Nation's work.

We already had several successful informal inter-governmental consultations with Member States and relevant stakeholders, including senior officials from diverse cities.

We would like to convene the fourth informal inter-governmental consultation at the United Nations Headquarters to engage with the Member States. This will be taking place on **Thursday 23rd May from 03:00 pm to 06:00 pm at Conference Room-11.**

During this informal consultation, we would like to recapitulate the inputs received so far and **elaborate our ideas on the possible contents of the zero draft.** As usual, we will be happy to receive your initial reactions to our ideas. In addition, our ideas on the modality resolution will be further consolidated with inputs from Geneva. Just like previous editions, we would appreciate receiving written inputs from you in timely manner.

We look forward to continuing working closely with you to ensure constructive intergovernmental negotiations and positive outcome, while we remain at your disposal for any clarification on the process.
