Excellency,

The General Assembly, in its resolution 73/131 and decision 73/522, decided that the one-day high-level meeting on universal health coverage to be convened by the President of the General Assembly shall be held in New York on Monday, 23 September 2019, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m., and consist of an opening segment, a plenary segment for general discussion, two multi-stakeholder panels and a brief closing segment.

The Assembly also decided that the plenary segment, to be held from 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 p.m. to 5.30 p.m., will comprise statements by Member States and observers of the General Assembly. Also, a list of speakers will be established in accordance with established practices of the Assembly, and the time limits for these statements will be three minutes for individual delegations and five minutes for statements made on behalf of a group of States.

In this regard, I have the honour to inform you that the list of speakers for the plenary segment will open for inscription on Monday, 19 August 2019 at 9:00 a.m. EDT and close on Monday, 16 September 2019 at 5:00 p.m. EDT. Delegations are invited to inscribe on the list of speakers through the e-speakers system available at https://delegate.un.int.

The provisional list of speakers will be made available in September 2019, prior to the high-level meeting.
