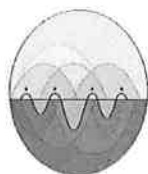
I thank all delegations for their interest in participating in this event, and I look forward to a successful mid-term review, tomorrow.

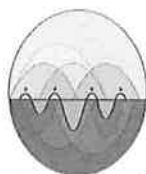
