

MEETING WITH H.E. JERRY MATTHEWS MATJILA, THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2019

28 October 2019

The President of the 74th Session of the UNGA, H.E. Tijjani Muhammad-Bande, met on 28 October 2019 with the Permanent Representative of South Africa and UNSC President for October 2019, H.E. Jerry Matthews Matjila. They discussed activities of the Council so far in October 2019 as well as the forthcoming 2020 review of the UN Peacebuilding Architecture.

The two Presidents decided to convene on 30 October 2019, a meeting of Chairs of regional groups with a view to interacting with them to move the review process forward.

The PGA had on 7 October 2019 transmitted, for the consideration of Member States, a letter from the Chair of the PBC proposing scope, Terms of Reference and modalities for conducting the review.
