The Permanent Mission of Israel to the United Nations presents its compliments to the President of the General Assembly and has the honor to refer to the President of the General Assembly's letter dated 27 May 2020, circulating for adoption under a silence procedure the draft resolution entitled, "Special session of the General Assembly against corruption" issued as document <u>A/74/L.58/Rev.2</u> under agenda item 106 (Crime prevention and criminal justice), as well as to General Assembly decision number 74/544 of 27 March 2020, entitled "Procedure for taking decisions of the General Assembly during the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic."

The Permanent Mission of Israel wishes to remind that draft resolution A/74/L.58/Rev.2 was not negotiated in NY and to inform the President of the General Assembly that Israel is not in a position to support Operative Paragraph 15 of the draft resolution and disassociates itself from the consensus on this paragraph.

The Permanent Mission of Israel to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the President of the General Assembly the assurances of its highest consideration.
