I, once again, appeal to all delegations to conclude this process on a text which already enjoys wide range of consensus, in order to have the draft Declaration ready for adoption and conveyed for that purpose to the seventy-fifth Session of the General Assembly.

I avail of this opportunity to express my solidarity with Member States who are fighting COVID-19 and extend my sincere condolences for their loss.
