Please find attached herewith the provisional list of speakers for the high-level meeting of the General Assembly to commemorate the seventy-fifth anniversary of the United Nations to be held on 21 September 2020.

The list has been prepared in accordance with resolution 73/299 and bearing in mind the role of the co-facilitators of the intergovernmental negotiations on the declaration to be adopted by consensus at the high-level meeting. As per established practice, if any delegation wishes to adjust the level of participation, the new speaker will feature at the end of the list of speakers at the adjusted level of participation.

Technical requirements for the submission of pre-recorded statements are included in my letter of 25 August 2020 on Audio Video Guidelines and in the Information Note (A/INF/75/4). It is kindly requested that all pre-recorded statements be submitted four days prior to the event (i.e. by Thursday, 17 September 2020) to ensure that they can be processed in time for the meeting. I also reiterate that as per resolution 73/299, statements are limited to three minutes for statements of individual delegations and five minutes for statements made on behalf of a group of States. Any pre-recorded statements which are longer than the allocated time may risk being cut short to ensure the maximum participation of speakers. As indicated in my letter dated 17 July 2020, the time limit shall include introductory remarks and the video itself.
