## <u>Subject: Results of the election of members of the International Court of Justice</u> held on 12 November 2020

Excellency,

Further to my joint letter with the President of the Security Council dated 4 November 2020 concerning the election of five members of the International Court of Justice, I am pleased to circulate the results of the voting that were announced at the 24<sup>th</sup> resumed plenary meeting held today, 12 November 2020 [see enclosed].

I have been informed by the President of the Security Council that at the 8773<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the Security Council, held on 11 November 2020, the following candidates had obtained an absolute majority of votes in the Security Council: IWASAWA Yuji (Japan), Georg NOLTE (Germany), Julia SEBUTINDE (Uganda), Peter TOMKA (Slovakia) and XUE Hanqin (China).

Having obtained the required absolute majority of votes in both the General Assembly and the Security Council, the following candidates have been elected members of the Court for a nine-year term of office beginning on 6 February 2021: IWASAWA Yuji (Japan), Georg NOLTE (Germany), Julia SEBUTINDE (Uganda), Peter TOMKA (Slovakia) and XUE Hanqin (China).
