As we start the resumed part of the seventy-fifth session of the General Assembly, I have the honour to inform you that I will convene the plenary meetings of the General Assembly on the following dates in January 2021:

- Informal meeting of the plenary on Thursday, 21 January 2021, at 10 a.m., in the General Assembly Hall - to brief the UN Membership about my priorities for the resumed part of the seventy-fifth session of the General Assembly in 2021;
- Also, as communicated earlier, informal meeting of the plenary on Wednesday, 27 January 2021, at 10 a.m. to hear a briefing by G-20 Sherpa of Italy, H.E. Ambassador Pietro Benassi, on the priorities of the G-20;
- Informal meeting of the plenary on Wednesday, 27 January 2021, at 3 p.m., in the General Assembly Hall – to hold a joint briefing of the Presidents of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council;
- Formal plenary meeting of the General Assembly on Thursday, 28 January 2021, at 10 a.m., in the General Assembly Hall - to hold a debate on agenda item 115 entitled “Report of the Secretary-General on the work of the Organization” during which the Secretary-General, H.E. Mr. António Guterres is invited to make a statement on his priorities for 2021. The formal meeting will then be suspended for an informal meeting of the Assembly to allow a question and answer segment with the membership.

Further information, including on the practical arrangements for participation in the briefings, will be provided in due course.
