I have the honour to refer to my letter dated 7 January 2021 regarding the plenary meeting of the General Assembly to be held on Thursday, 28 January 2021, at 10 a.m., in the General Assembly Hall, to hold a debate on agenda item 115 entitled “Report of the Secretary-General on the work of the Organization”.

At the start of the plenary meeting I will invite the Secretary-General, H.E. Mr. António Guterres, to make a statement on his priorities for 2021.

Thereafter, the formal meeting will be suspended for an informal meeting to allow comments and questions from the membership. This segment will not have a pre-established list of speakers. In order to allow maximum participation delegations are requested to keep their interventions concise and not longer than two minutes for individual delegations and three minutes for statements made on behalf of a group of States.

The formal meeting will then resume for delegations to deliver statements under agenda item 115. Delegations wishing to be inscribed on the list of speakers for the formal debate on the item are kindly requested to do so through the e-deleGATE portal.
