Mr. Cheikh Niang, Permanent Representative of Senegal, the co-facilitators for the intergovernmental negotiations, on the breaking of the silence procedure. The co-facilitators will consult with Member States and groups with a view to finding a solution, and putting the final draft resolutions under silence procedure at the earliest opportunity.

I highly encourage all Member States and groups to engage constructively and cooperate with the co-facilitators in this final stage.
