I have the honour to inform you that, following the request from a group of Member States and taking advantage of the presence of the Special Envoy of the UN Secretary-General on Myanmar, Ms. Christine Schraner Burgener, in New York, I will convene an informal meeting of the General Assembly to hear a briefing by the Special Envoy. The briefing will be held pursuant to operative paragraph 21 (c) of General Assembly resolution A/RES/75/238 on the situation of human rights of Rohingya Muslims and other minorities in Myanmar.

The briefing will take place immediately after the formal plenary meeting of the General Assembly to consider draft resolution L.85/rev.1 on the situation in Myanmar on Friday 18 June 2021 at 3 p.m. in the General Assembly Hall of the United Nations Headquarters.

Please note that there will be no pre-established list of speakers for this informal meeting. Delegations are welcome to take the floor by pressing the button from their national seat.
