Further to my letter dated 19 May 2021 regarding the high-level supporting event on the margins of the Special Session of the General Assembly on Challenges and Measures to Prevent and Combat Corruption and Strengthen International Cooperation, to be held virtually on Thursday, 3 June 2021, from 1:30-2:45 pm., I have the honour to circulate herewith the programme of the event.

As provided in the programme, following the moderated discussion among panellists there will be question and answer period (approximately 45 minutes) during which Member States may pose questions to the panellists.
