Excellency,

I have the honour to write regarding the nomination of members of the board of the 10 Year Framework of Programmes on Sustainable Consumption and Production patterns (10YFP).

The 10-member board of the 10YFP, consisting of two members from each United Nations regional group, was established by the General Assembly in paragraph 5 of its resolution 67/203, entitled “Implementation of Agenda 21, the Programme for Further Implementation of Agenda 21 and the outcomes of the World Summit on Sustainable Development and of the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development”.

In General Assembly decision 67/564 of 16 September 2013, the Assembly took note of the establishment of the board of the 10YFP and decided that the members of the board shall serve for an initial term of two years effective from 16 September. Additionally, the Assembly decided that regional groups shall be authorized to nominate new members of the board after the completion of the initial two-year term, or in the event of the resignation of a member of the board, and for subsequent terms, upon notification of the President of the General Assembly and the board by the relevant regional group. Regional groups may also renominate one of their existing two members of the board for one consecutive term, while ensuring that no Member State may be eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms.
