Excellency,

Following up on the letter dated 20 August 2021, I am pleased to share the list of speakers for the High-level plenary meeting of the General Assembly to commemorate and promote the International Day for the Total Elimination of Nuclear Weapons, scheduled for 28 September 2021, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 to 6 p.m., in-person in the General Assembly Hall.

The time limit for statements, which will be strictly observed, will be three minutes for individual delegations and five minutes for statements made on behalf of a group of States. Delegations wishing to submit a pre-recorded statement are invited to refer to the Information note for delegations concerning the arrangements for the high-level meetings and the general debate of the seventy-sixth session of the General Assembly issued as document A/INF/76/4/Rev.1. Speakers are welcome to include multimedia elements in their pre-recorded videos as long as the full length of the video does not exceed the time limits indicated. Pre-recorded statements should be received no later than Friday, 24 September 2021. Submitted pre-recorded statements will be made available at https://www.un.org/en/observances/nuclear-weapons-elimination-day.

Given the large number of speakers inscribed, it will be presumed that delegations will not be introducing their respective pre-recorded statements; rather the presiding officer will introduce the pre-recorded statements. Any delegation that intends to introduce its pre-recorded statement should communicate this in writing to 1stcommittee@un.org by 24 September 2021.

In order to limit the footprint and the number of people on United Nations premises, presence in the General Assembly Hall for Member or Observer States and the delegation of the European Union will be limited to four delegates per delegation (including the Head of State or Government).

The final list of speakers for the high-level plenary meeting will be made available on Monday, 27 September 2021.
