I have the pleasure to refer to my predecessor's letter dated 10 September 2021, transmitting a letter from H.E. Mr. Sofiane Mimouni, Permanent Representative of Algeria, and H.E. Mr. Martin Bille Hermann, Permanent Representative of Denmark, the co-facilitators appointed in relation to the Secretary-General's report on the review of the functioning of the resident coordinator system and related intergovernmental consultation process, as required, pursuant to General Assembly resolutions 72/279 and 75/233.
