Excellency,


In its resolution 75/283 entitled “Modalities, format and organization of the high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the appraisal of the United Nations Global Plan of Action to Combat Trafficking in Persons”, in particular operative paragraph 9, the General Assembly

“Request[ed] the President of the General Assembly to draw up a list of representatives of other relevant non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions and the private sector who may participate in the high-level meeting, including its panel discussions, taking into account the principles of transparency and equitable geographical representation, with due regard for gender parity, to submit the proposed list to Member States for their consideration on a non-objection basis¹ and to bring the list to the attention of the Assembly for a final decision by the Assembly on participation in the high-level meeting”.

In this regard, I have the honour to enclose herewith, for your consideration, a list of representatives of non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions and the private sector, which have applied to participate in the high-level meeting, including its panel discussions, from 22 to 23 November 2021.

If I do not hear from you by 5 p.m., on Thursday, 4 November 2021, I will take it that there is general agreement on the list.
