Given the importance of debt sustainability for the achievement of the SDGs, we have the honour to convene a Joint High-level Thematic Debate on "Debt Sustainability for better recovery", to be held on Tuesday, 31 May 2022, in the United Nations Headquarters. We have the further honour to circulate herewith the **concept note** and **provisional programme**.

The Joint High-Level Thematic Debate will bring together Member States and Observers, the UN System, international financial institutions, the private sector, academia, and civil society to discuss scaling-up coordinated efforts by the international community to provide immediate relief to countries in need, and to urgently prevent and resolve future debt crises. It will discuss the progress achieved on debt issues and reflect on implementable measures and concrete actions to mitigate unsustainable debt in the context of a sustainable recovery from COVID19, taking into consideration the outcomes of the ECOSOC 2022 Financing for Development Forum.
