Excellency,

We are honored to write you in our capacity as co-facilitators of the intergovernmental process to prepare an elements' paper on the Declaration on Future Generations.

We are pleased to share with you information on the tentative schedule and milestones of this process.

On Thursday **7 July 2022 from 10:00 – 13:00** we will organize informal consultations among Member States. In preparation of the consultations we will organize an in-person expert briefing for Member States on Thursday, **30 June 2022 from 10:00 – 12:00** in the Trusteeship Council Chamber. During this expert briefing we will recapture what has been discussed during the OCA consultations on future generations and set the scene of our discussion on the topic. Following the expert briefing and informal consultation, we invite Member States and other stakeholders to provide written inputs to the elements' paper by Wednesday **10 August 2022**. Early September a second informal consultation among Member States is foreseen to discuss the inputs and reflections provided.

To facilitate the organization of discussions and consultations, Member States wishing to participate are kindly invited to nominate a **focal point** and communicate contact details to lisa.gotoh@minbuza.nl by **28 June 2022 COB**. Further details will be communicated in due course.

We would be grateful if this letter could be circulated to all delegations ahead of the meeting.
