Excellency,

We wish to refer to the letter dated 20 May 2022 from the President of the General Assembly, H.E. Abdulla Shahid, in which he informed Member States of his decision to appoint us as Co-Facilitators of the Intergovernmental Negotiations on Financing for Peacebuilding.

We would like to express our appreciation to the President of the General Assembly as well as to the membership for the trust and confidence placed on us to facilitate this important and timely process.

In our capacity as Co-Facilitators, we would like to inform you that upon assuming our responsibilities, we are currently conducting a number of informal informal consultations with Regional Groups and Member States to discuss possible elements for a negotiated outcome document. Wanting to ensure a transparent, inclusive and consultative process, we invite Member States to provide input on specific funding mechanisms and streams to address the identified peacebuilding financing gap, including actionable solutions and member state-led initiatives to help ensure adequate, predictable and sustained financing for peacebuilding, based on the President of the General's summary of the High-level Meeting on Financing for Peacebuilding held on 27 and 29 April 2022. After concluding the informal informal consultations with Regional Groups and Member States, we will have the first informal consultations of the whole to present the zero-draft scheduled for 15th of July 2022 from 3-6pm at the Trusteeship Council.

We also wish to note that further information including a timeline of upcoming meetings with dates and venues will be shared with delegations in due course.

We affirm our availability for consultations throughout the process ahead of us to ensure it remains inclusive, transparent, consultative and member state driven. We look forward to the active participation and constructive engagement of all delegations both in consultations, meetings of the whole and the entire session of the intergovernmental process with the aim of a clear, action-oriented, and focused outcome resolution on financing for peacebuilding.
