We have the pleasure to enclose the **summary** of the High-Level Special Event entitled 'Time To Act Together: Coordinating Policy Responses To The Global Food Security Crisis' held on Monday, 18 July 2022 from 3.00 – 6.00 p.m. (EDT) in the Trusteeship Council Chamber at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

The special event brought together Member States, Observers, different agencies of the United Nations, the private sector, academia, and civil society representatives for an inclusive dialogue on the global food crisis in the context of the recent turmoil in global food markets as multiple challenges - climate change, the pandemic, conflict, and economic uncertainty, converge. It captured the urgency of the issue and generated pragmatic recommendations on how we can coordinate better globally to overcome the global food crisis. The summary identifies key messages from these discussions.

We hope that the summary will support collective efforts to address challenges to food security, and multilateral action towards that goal.
