ANNEX

Informal interactive dialogues with candidates for the position of the President of the General Assembly.

In its resolution 71/323, the General Assembly decided to conduct informal interactive dialogues with candidates for the position of President of the General Assembly, thus contributing to the transparency and inclusivity of the process and called upon candidates to present to the Assembly their vision statements.

The General Assembly, in its subsequent resolution 73/341, requested the dialogues to be organized as a question and answer session with targeted and relevant questions that serve as a follow-up to the vision statements of the candidates, and draw on the plans and priorities of each candidate for their term.

The proposed format for the informal interactive dialogue with the candidates for the position of the President of the 78th session of the General Assembly are as follows:

- The dialogues will be presided over by the President of the General Assembly and last up to three hours.
- The dialogue will begin with a presentation of the candidate's vision statement for the Presidency (up to 10 minutes), followed by an interactive exchange.
- Member States are encouraged to ask concise questions, with interventions not exceeding 2 minutes for individual delegations and 3 minutes for groups.
- Interventions from Member States will be on a first-come, first-served basis, bearing in mind requests from groups.
- The candidates will be given the opportunity to respond to questions at regular intervals during the dialogues.
- The candidates will have the opportunity to respond to questions from other stakeholders, including questions to be selected from questions received through the website of the President of the General Assembly prior to the dialogues.
- In line with the overall objective of increasing the transparency and inclusivity of the process, the informal interactive dialogues will be webcast.
