Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the General Assembly resolutions on the three health-related high-level meetings to be held in September 2023, namely resolution 75/315 entitled "Scope, modalities, format and organization of the high-level meeting on universal health coverage"; resolution 77/274 entitled "Scope, modalities, format and organization of the high-level meeting on the fight against tuberculosis"; and resolution 77/275 entitled "Scope, modalities, format and organization of the high-level meeting on pandemic prevention, preparedness and response".

In paragraph 10 of each of the aforementioned resolutions, the General Assembly:

"Requests the President of the General Assembly to draw up a list of representatives of other relevant non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions and the private sector who may participate in the high-level meeting, including its panel discussions, taking into account the principles of transparency and equitable geographical representation, with due regard for gender parity, to submit the proposed list to Member States for their consideration on a non-objection basis and to bring the list to the attention of the Assembly for a final decision by the Assembly on participation in the high-level meeting".

Accordingly, I have the honour to enclose herewith, for your consideration, three lists of relevant non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions and the private sector which have applied to participate in the respective high-level meetings.

My office will receive official communications concerning the attached lists until **14 July 2023**, at **5:00 p.m.** Thereafter, I intend to circulate three corresponding draft decisions to all Member States, with a view to take action on the final draft decisions on **25 July 2023** in the General Assembly.
