We also invite you to submit written comments on the zero-draft by Friday January 19, 2024 at 6pm to Ms Carla Galea (carla.b.galea@gov.mt) from the Permanent Mission of Malta and Ms Melissa Straker-Taylor (mtaylor@foreign.gov.bb) from the Permanent Mission of Barbados. A compilation text will then be circulated prior to the first round of consultations, which will take place on Wednesday January 24, 2024 at 3pm at the Trusteeship Council Chamber.

In preparation for the negotiation process, please find attached a zero-draft of the modalities resolution.
