Excellency,

I have the honour to transmit herewith a letter dated 23 July 2024 from H.E. Ms. Maritza Chan Valverde, Permanent Representative of Costa Rica to the United Nations and H.E. Ms. Carolyn Schwalger, Permanent Representative of New Zealand to the United Nations, Co-facilitators to conduct open, transparent and inclusive consultations with Member States to finalize the organizational arrangements, including on a possible outcome document, for the high-level plenary meeting of the General Assembly on addressing the existential threats posed by sea-level rise.

The Co-facilitators hereby inform that the silence procedure for the draft resolution entitled “*Scope, modalities, format and organization of the high-level plenary meeting on addressing the existential threats posed by sea-level rise*” and draft decision entitled “*Enhancing action on sea-level rise*” has concluded.

In this regard, I intend to submit the draft resolution, to be issued as A/78/L.100, and the draft decision, to be issued as A/78/L.101, to the General Assembly for its consideration at the plenary meeting on Thursday, 1 August at 10 a.m., in the General Assembly Hall. The full programme of the meeting will be published in the *Journal of the United Nations*.

Once again, I would like to thank the Co-facilitators for their tireless efforts to bring this process to a positive conclusion. My sincere appreciation also goes to the delegations for their constructive engagement and flexibility throughout the process.
