In this regard, we are pleased to organize the presentation of the zero draft resolution entitled “Scope, modalities, format and organization of the High-Level Meeting on the thirtieth anniversary of the Fourth World Conference on Women” on **Wednesday 12 February 2025 at 3.00pm in the ECOSOC Chamber**.
