Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 79/293, I have the honour to inform you that I will convene an informal plenary meeting of the General Assembly to commemorate and promote the International Day against Unilateral Coercive Measures on Thursday, 4 December 2025 at 10 a.m. in the General Assembly Hall.

The informal plenary meeting will consist of an opening segment and a plenary segment. Delegations wishing to deliver statements at the plenary segment are invited to inscribe in the list of speakers through e-deleGATE portal, which will be open on Monday, 27 October 2025 at 10 a.m. The time limits for statements will be three minutes for individual delegations and five minutes for statements made on behalf of a group of states. The time limit will be strictly enforced by means of automatic microphone cut-off.
