On 9 October 2013, the General Assembly in resolution 68/6 adopted the Outcome document of the Special Event to follow up efforts made towards achieving the Millennium Development Goals, which included the decision to launch a process of intergovernmental negotiations at the beginning of the sixty-ninth session, which will lead to the adoption of the Post-2015 Development Agenda.

I have the honour to inform you that following consultations, I have appointed H.E. Mr. David Donoghue, Permanent Representative of Ireland and H.E. Mr. Macharia Kamau, Permanent Representative of Kenya, as Co-Facilitators to lead open, inclusive, and transparent consultations on the post-2015 development agenda, including the organization and modalities for the intergovernmental negotiations and the remaining issues related to the Summit for the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda.

I would like to thank Ambassador Donoghue and Ambassador Kamau for accepting this important responsibility and trust that you will extend full support and cooperation to them.
