In his letter dated 13 October 2014, the President of the General Assembly appointed the Permanent Representatives of Croatia and Namibia as Co-Chairs of the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Revitalization of the Work of the General Assembly at the 69th session, open to all Member States, which was established pursuant to Resolution 68/307 of 10 September 2014 to “identify further ways to enhance the role, authority, effectiveness and efficiency of the Assembly, inter alia, by building on the progress achieved in past sessions as well as on previous resolutions, including evaluating the status of their implementation and to submit a report thereon to the Assembly at its sixty-ninth session.”

By the same resolution, it was further decided that the AHWG shall continue its review of the inventory of General Assembly resolutions on revitalization annexed to the report of the AHWG submitted at the 68th session of the Assembly, and continue to update the inventory to be attached to the report at the 69th session. We as Co-Chairs have the honor to invite you to the first meeting of the AHWG to be held on Tuesday, 3 March, at 10 p.m. in the Trusteeship Council Chamber (CB). The meeting will then provide delegations with an opportunity for a first round of exchange of views on the Working Group’s deliberations during the 69th session.
