We have now concluded two of our drafting sessions on the road to the Third International Conference on Financing for Development in Addis Ababa in July. Mindful of the importance of the Conference and the time available, we would like to express our gratitude for your constructive contributions which have enabled us to make progress together in our work.

In order to move the process forward, we wish to inform you that additional sessions for consultations on the Draft Outcome Document have been scheduled from 11-15 May and 26-29 May, with provision also for 1-5 June.

The revised Draft will be based on views and comments during the Second Drafting Session, the Joint Session with the Post 2015 process on means of implementation and the written inputs that we have received.
