<u>Subject</u>: Explanation of Chilean position on Draft decision entitled "2020 United Nations Conference to Support the Implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development" (A/74/L.48)

Excellency,

The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations has the honour to refer to the letter dated of 7 April 2020, circulated by the distinguished Office of the President of the 74th Session of the General Assembly, on the draft resolution entitled "2020 United Nations Conference to Support the Implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development", contained in document A/74/L.48.

As a first comment, Chile would like to thank to the co-organizers, Portugal and Kenya, for its efforts to host the Second Conference on Oceans.

Regarding the draft decision, Chile joins the consensus and also stresses the importance of celebrating the 2020 UN Conference on Oceans in a later date and welcomes that the decision does not imply the cancelation of this important event.

Chile has a strong commitment with the conservation of the oceans and the sustainable use of its resources and reiterates its commitment to the preparatory process carried out by the co-facilitators.

Finally, the Permanent Mission of Chile wants to point out that other international fora, such as COP26, have also been postponed. In particular, the dialogue on the ocean and climate change will take place on October 2020, during the 52nd Meeting of the Subsidiary Body of the Convention (SB52). General Assembly Resolution 73/292 recognizes the synergies of the Paris Agreement process with the UN Ocean Conference, which remains open to other contributions.

The Permanent Mission of Chile avails of this opportunity to reiterate to the Ambassador Tijjani Muhammad-Bande, President of the General Assembly, the assurances of its highest consideration.
