
UNECE

Inflation pressures are widespread




Consumer inflation, monthly, year-on-year, percentages

Greenhouse gas emissions in the ECE region, million metric tons of CO2 equivalent








Minerals used in clean energy technologies compared to other sources





Leveraging funding sources to maximize ECE impact at country level



- Technical Cooperation projects = key in helping governments accede to and ECE norms and standards.
- Seed funding from RPTC and UNDA = catalytic & key to fast response
- Strong collaboration with Resident Coordinators and UN Country Teams
- Unique system of dedicated Regional Advisors

Country-level engagement 2022 examples



- ECE part of Joint SDG Fund Development Emergency Modality, in response to the Global Crisis on Food, Energy, Finance:
 - Ukraine: biofuel production potential
 - Georgia: energy efficiency measures in rural areas;
- ECE repurposed part of RPTC to respond to the requests sent by the government of Ukraine: urban reconstruction planning, energy, trade facilitation and transport.
