

### Digital divide remains a challenge

#### **Gender Divide**

In the region, 61% of women use the Internet, against 67% of men.

#### **Generational Divide**

13% of 75-year-olds and above use the Internet, against 97% of 15-24-year-olds.

#### **Disability Divide**

83% of women with disabilities use a mobile phone, against 92% of women without disabilities.

Similar results are observed among men.

#### **Geographical Divide**

47% of people living in rural areas use the Internet, against 82% of those living in urban areas.











#### Intelligent transport systems market sizes, by region, 2022 vs 2031







#### Main challenges for the Development of Smart Transport Systems


