

Some of the responses



If the questions were given to the participants in advance, it would provide more opportunity to enter the issues.


The time for discussion at breakout sessions was not adequate. More time could have produced better results.

Knowledge dissemination procedure should be improved.


In your opinion, did the workshop cover all the presented topics adequately?
