1. To develop and publicize an integrated national strategy for the justice and security sector, by the end of the year 2013;
  2. To develop a multiyear strategy and establish a sexual and gender-based violence unit in all of our 15 counties, by 2015;
  3. To establish a civilian oversight board for the Liberian National Police, by the year 2013, to accept complaints from the public of acts of police misconduct;
  4. To ratify Optional Protocol nb. III [to the Convention on the Rights of the Child], specifically dealing with sexual exploitation and sale of children;
  5. Introducing new legislation and training programmes to tackle transnational crimes, by mid-2013.
