



Achievements

- → 19 Joint Airport Interdiction Task Forces (JAITFs) operational and 5 additional
 JAITFs established
- 2 Canine Teams Trained and Operational
- 15 joint operations
- **♦** Seizures
 - 3,174 kg of cocaine; 1,417 kg of cannabis; 1,230 kg methamphetamine and 18,5 kg of amphetamine and 168 kg of heroin
 - 1,397 kg of counterfeit medicines and 541 kg of ivory
 - US\$ 6.5 million, as well as fake passports and ammunitions
 - Interception of potential FTFs in West Africa and LAC



AIRCOP and high-risk passengers

- **♦** Roll out to the MENA region
 - Training curriculum and training on profiling of FTF
- ♦ JAITFs in countries with heightened risk in Africa and LAC
 - Detection of explosives
 - Detection/interception of FTF

Fostering cross-regional cooperation

- Real-time communication tools and databases
- Networks of officers created through training, mentoring and exchange programmes
 - Example of Intercops
- Joint operations







AIRCOP – Good practices

- Operational structures to strengthen inter-agency cooperation
- Full coverage of airport settings (passengers, cargo and postal services)
- Real-time communication tools and databases
- Profiling/targeting techniques transferable to all types of threats
- Improved south-south, regional and international operational communication, by linking source, transit and destination countries
- Entry points for further bilateral, regional and international cooperation





Way forward

- Strengthening profiling and data analysis capacity of existing JAITFs
- Increasing the exchange of operational information regionally and globally
- Establishing new JAITFs along high-risk routes / key hubs
- Strengthening partnerships with ICAO and airlines
- Improving capacity of JAITFs on analysis of API/PNR data (including software)
- Evidence collection and handling
- Integration of JAITFs in the counter-terrorist structure of the different countries
