Explanatory Note

SCOPE

1. This index, prepared by the Documentation Services Division of the Dag Hammarskjold Library at United Nations Headquarters, is intended to offer a bibliographical guide to the proceedings and documentation of the organizational session for 1976 and the sixtieth session of the Economic and Social Council and of its committees or <u>ad</u> hoc committees that met during the session.

ARRANGEMENT

2. The index consists of the following parts for each session:

(a) Introduction, including list of officers and checklists of meetings of the Economic and Social Council and its sessional committees;

(b) Agenda, with reference to the relevant subject headings used in part (c);

(c) <u>Subject index.</u> Subjects are arranged alphabetically, with reference to the documentation, discussion, and disposition of each item. Agenda item numbers are indicated in parentheses following the subject headings. Names of delegations are noted in parentheses following the meeting number whenever statements are made on a subject not scheduled as an agenda item or on a subject referred to in the general debate in plenary meetings;

(d) Index to speeches. Speeches and statements by representatives are listed in alphabetical order by country or organization, subdivided by subject discussed and by name of speaker, with an indication of the meeting at which the speech was made. The speeches of chairmen and rapporteurs of committees are included when they presented or explained the reports of their committees to the Council. Statements and speeches made by private individuals representing an organization to which a hearing was granted are listed under the name of the organization. Statements made by officers of the United Nations Secretariat are listed under the name of the office or department they represented; (e) <u>Numerical list of documents</u>, arranged by document symbols.

AVAILABILITY OF DOCUMENTS

3. All summary records of plenary and committee meetings of the Economic and Social Council appear first in provisional mimeographed form. They may be identified by their symbol, which consists of the series symbol (e.g., E/-, E/AC. 7/-) as indicated in the introduction (see Checklist of meetings), followed by SR and a number corresponding to that of the meeting (e.g., E/SR. 1991; E/AC. 7/SR. 780). Summary records of plenary meetings are later printed in the <u>Official Records</u>. Summary records of committee meetings are combined in a cumulated mimeographed document.

Of the other documents, a few appear only as printed <u>Supplements</u> to the <u>Official Records</u> (a fact always noted in this index), but the rest are issued only in mimeographed form. Beginning in 1974, the preparation of the <u>Annexes</u> of <u>Official Records</u> of the Economic and Social Council were discontinued since the substance of all reports of committees of the Council are included in the annual report to the General Assembly. Resolutions and decisions adopted by the Economic and Social Council, first issued in mimeographed form, are collected in printed <u>Supplements</u> to the Official Records of the session.
