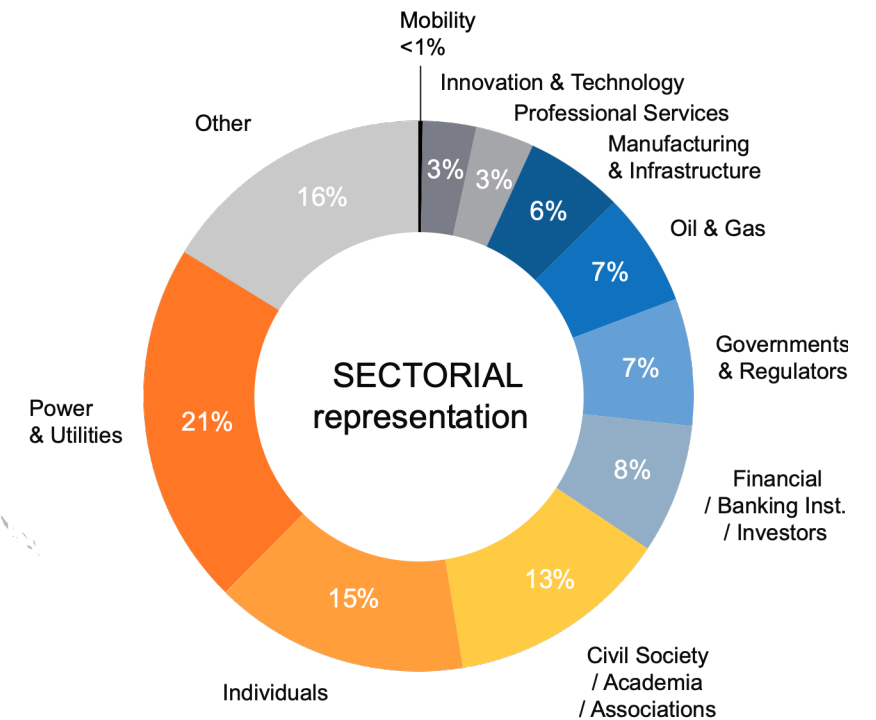
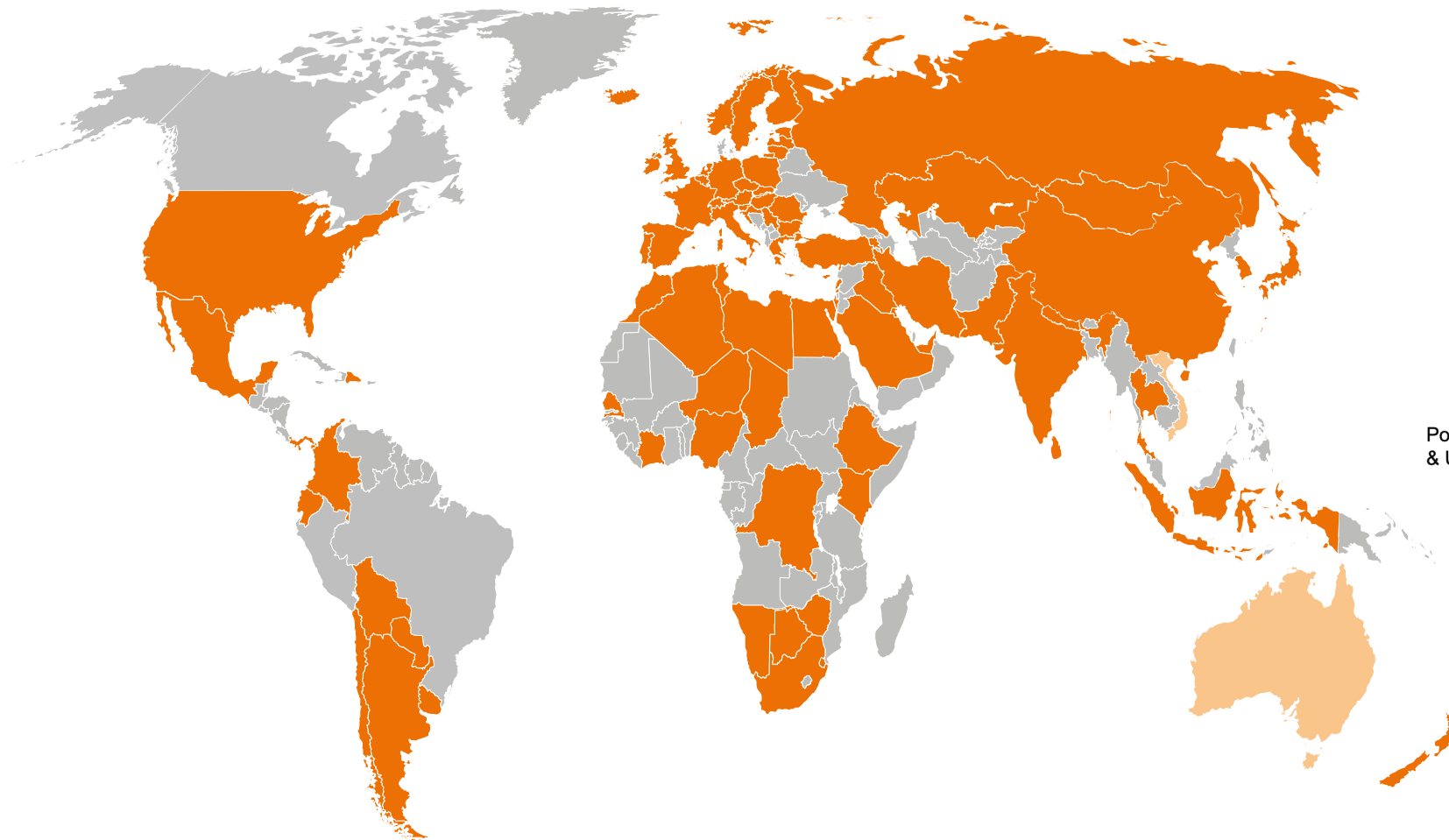

It benefits from a balanced approach and the involvement of multiple stakeholders.

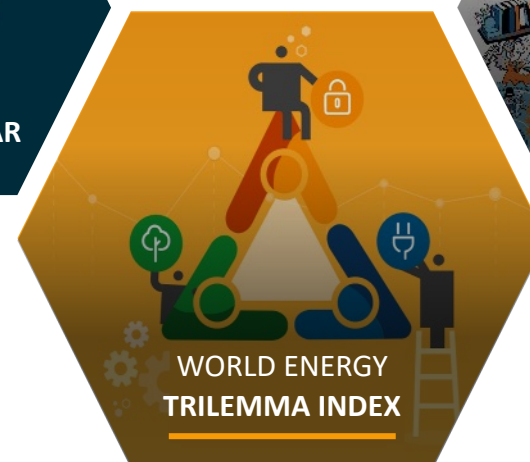
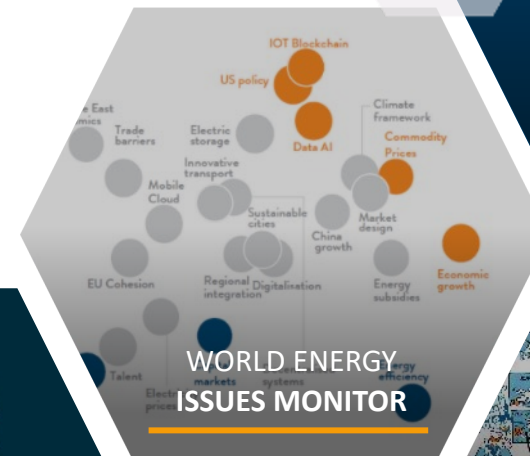
We promote whole system understanding to **enable effective action**.

Eligibility & Application

- Annual refresh and application process, selection by FEL-100 Board
- Max age on application 32 years
- 3-5 years junior management experience considered a plus
- Availability for at least 15 days contact time with programme p.a.
- Evaluation based on minimum engagement criteria & quality of contributions

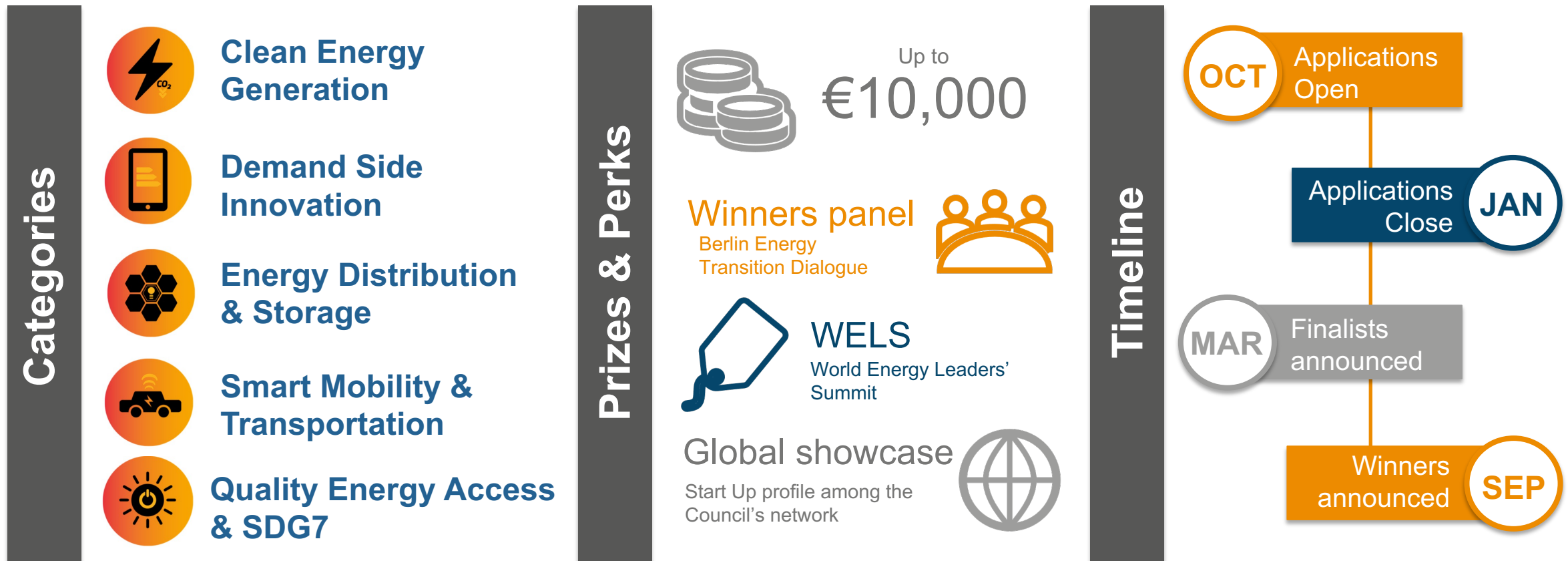
