It's a broad coalition of more than twenty-five Dutch organizations representing the business community, finance, civil society, academia and government.

In addition, we are contributing 100 million US Dollars to the **Climate Investment Funds**, intended for the Renewable Energy Integration program.

And we're opening the second call for proposals of the **SDG7 Results Facility**, which offers grants for creating access to renewable energy – based on the number of people reached.

So the Netherlands is doing its share.

But we also count on all of you to help accelerate the global energy transition.

And to make sure we leave no one behind.
