We shall engage the youth in designing and developing digital innovative solutions while creating youth centric opportunities meaningful engagement, participation and access to resources so as to enhance and scale up digital practices and innovations.

Ladies and gentlemen, excellencies. As I conclude I reiterate that Somalia remains supportive of food systems and achieving SDGs 2030.
