## Additional Information on Special Registration Arrangements for In-person Participants

In order to address the public health and safety concerns arising from the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Host Government is requesting all in-person participants at the Conference to provide additional information related to their vaccination status. For this reason, the UN registration process (using the Indico system as explained in the Information Note for the Conference) will be supplemented by an additional registration process, which will be fully managed by the Host Country. (Link to the Host Country registration site: <a href="https://reg.transport-dev.org.cn/">https://reg.transport-dev.org.cn/</a>) As a result of this process, an 'Access Pass' will be issued by the Host Country to all in-person participants, in addition to the UN Badge. This pass is required for all three days of the Conference (14-16 October 2021) to enter the Conference venue -- China National Convention Center (CNCC) in Beijing.

The details of this registration process and access policy are provided below:

1. All in-person participants will need a unique "invitation code" sent by the Ministry of Transport, which is required to access the registration website. Participants are required to provide basic information and proof of vaccination. Upon verification with the authorities for public health, a confirmation will be issued via email to the participants.

2. In order to gain access to the CNCC, all participants will be required to wear their 'Access Pass' (or, for VIP participants, an equivalent Special Pin) upon entry.

3. A Special Pin (for Chinese Ministers, Ambassadors and Heads of international organizations only) or 'Access Pass' with the 'Opening Ceremony' mark will be required to attend the Opening Ceremony and First Plenary Session on 14 October 2021.

4. The UN badge is required for the duration of the Conference.

5. The UN badges and the Access Passes can **only** be collected on Wednesday, 13 October 2021, at CNCC, Room VIP1-1 on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor (enter from Gate C4 and turn left) between 8am and 10pm Beijing time. Passes and badges can be collected by a designated official, presenting the corresponding authorization as per the Information Note (available on the website). When collecting the Access Passes, proof of a negative nucleic acid test conducted on 12 or 13 October 2021, proof of completion of vaccination, as well as the green travel code/21-day health monitoring proof (screenshot) will need to be presented for all participants for which the passes are being collected.

6. Starting from midnight (00:01 hrs) of Thursday, 14 October 2021, Access Passes are required for anyone to enter CNCC.

7. We appreciate the understanding and cooperation by all in-person participants with the implementation of these exceptional measures, which are intended to ensure the highest level of safety and health for everybody.
