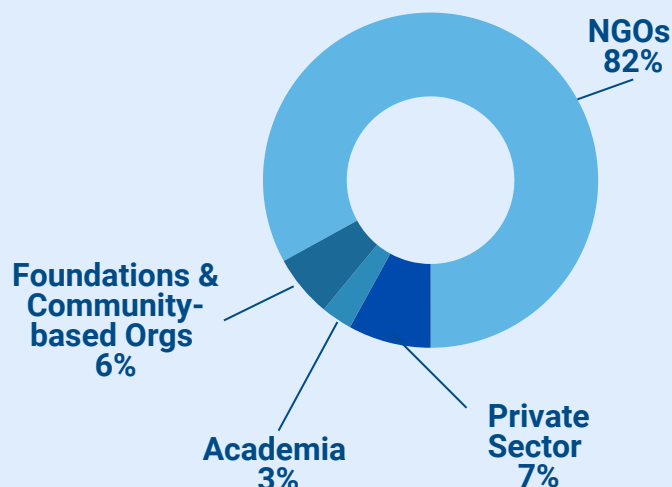

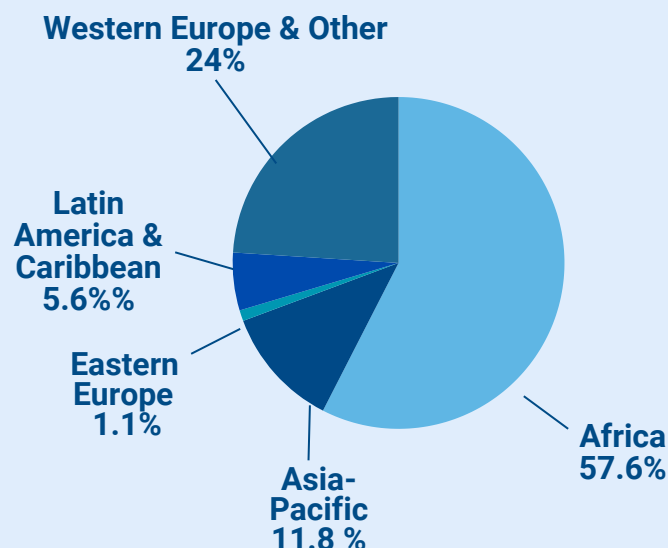

## CIVIL SOCIETY PARTICIPATION TRENDS & INSIGHTS



**36.5%**

### YOUTH PARTICIPATION

36.5% of participants across all high-level events were youth (ages 18-34)



**49.5%**

### GENDER DISTRIBUTION

49.5% of participants were female (self-identified), reflecting an equal gender distribution.



**57.6%**

### REPRESENTATION

- 57.6% of participants were from Africa.
- 21.5% of participants were from Small Island Developing States (SIDS) & Least Developed Countries (LDCs)
