## Supplementary modalities for the accreditation of non-governmental organizations and other relevant stakeholders to the third United Nations Conference on Landlocked Developing Countries and its preparatory process

The Preparatory Committee for the third United Nations Conference on Landlocked Developing Countries, recalling its resolution entitled "Additional modalities and format of the third United Nations Conference on Landlocked Developing Countries", adopted on 13 September 2023, <sup>1</sup> decides to approve the following supplementary modalities for the accreditation of non-governmental organizations and other relevant stakeholders to the Conference and its preparatory process:

Other relevant stakeholders, including civil society organizations, (a) academic institutions, the private sector and non-governmental organizations not in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council that were accredited to the Global Conference on the Sustainable Development of Small Island Developing States, the International Meeting to Review the Implementation of the Programme of Action for the Sustainable Development of Small Island Developing States, the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development, the third International Conference on Small Island Developing States, the international meeting entitled "Stockholm+50: a healthy planet for the prosperity of all – our responsibility, our opportunity", the 2022 United Nations Conference to Support the Implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 14: Conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development, the Fifth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries, the United Nations Conference on the Midterm Comprehensive Review of the Implementation of the Objectives of the International Decade for Action, "Water for Sustainable Development", 2018-2028 or the fourth

International Conference on Small Island Developing States should register in order to participate in the Conference and its preparatory process;

(b) In addition, any further requests for accreditation from other relevant non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions, and the private sector not in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council shall provide evidence of legal status and the information outlined in paragraphs 44 (a) and (b) of Economic and Social Council resolution 1996/31 of 25 July 1996;

(c) Any further list drawn up in accordance with paragraph 51 (c) of General Assembly resolution 77/246 of 30 December 2022 will be disseminated at least five days before the decision is taken by the General Assembly and no later than April 2024.
