



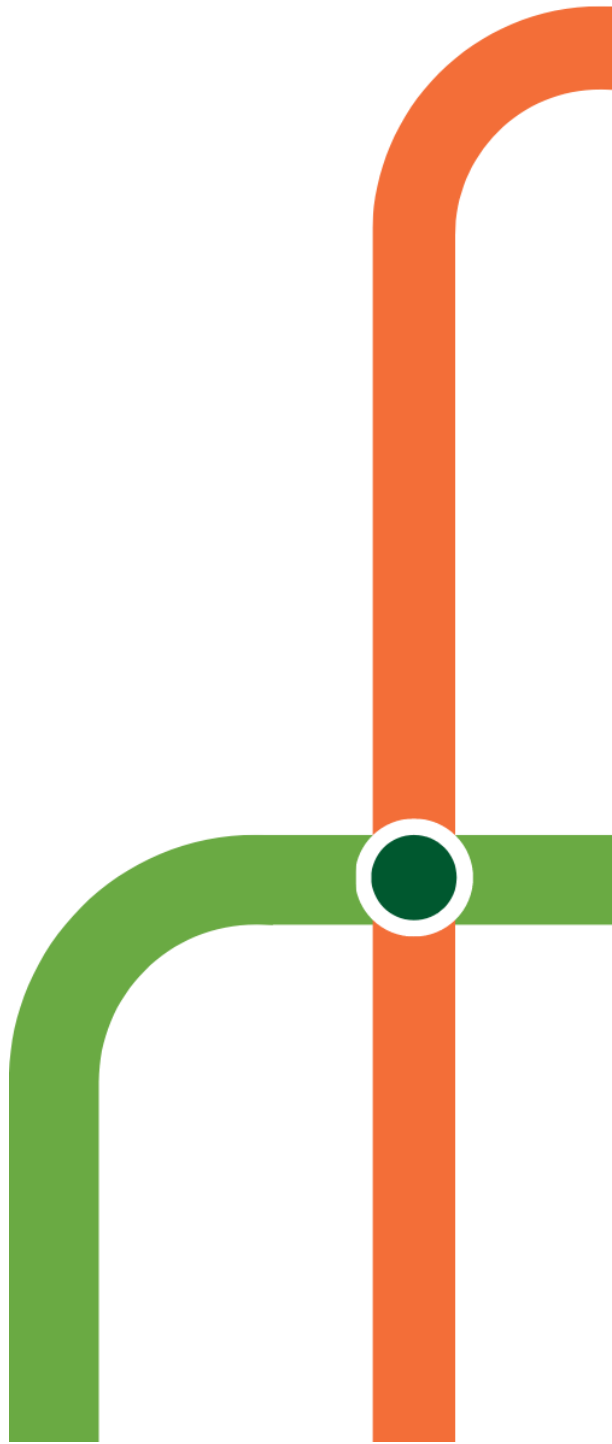

Proposed Consultation Questions for LLDC3 Youth Declaration

1 Mechanism of the consultation

Consultations to be done online at regional level involving key stakeholders, the youth, youth organisations, youth serving organisations, youth ministries and other key stakeholders. 3 Online consultation sessions facilitated by OHRLLS will be held between April and May 2024.

2 General Guiding Questions

What does it mean for you to be young in one of the world's Landlocked Developed Countries?

How are you contributing to making your community better?

3 Thematic Questions:

THEMATIC AREA 1: DIGITAL STRUCTURAL TRANSFORMATION AND SCIENCE , INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES AND INNOVATION

- What measures/ actions should be put in place to ensure that youths are involved and supported in science, information and communication technology (ICTs) and innovation in your country.
- What policies and systems do you feel your government should put in place to ensure that there is intellectual property protection of innovations?
- What policies and strategies should be considered to ensure that youth from LLDCs (all youth regardless of their gender, ability , educational or socio-economic status) can have equal and equitable access to digital information and they are able to use it to foster their educational and socio-economic development.
- What measures/ actions should be put in place to ensure that youths are incentivised to follow, be involved in studies and jobs and supported in science, technology and innovation in your country.

THEMATIC AREA 2: TRADE, TRADE FACILITATION AND REGIONAL INTEGRATION

- What measures should be implemented to enhance trade facilitation and streamline customs procedures to make trade more efficient and accessible for young entrepreneurs?
- How can young people be involved in the implementation of regional trade agreements?
- What measures/actions should be implemented to ensure that young people are capacitated to compete in regional and global markets?

THEMATIC AREA 3: TRANSIT, TRANSPORT AND CONNECTIVITY

- What strategies should be employed to improve trade corridors to enhance economic opportunities and mobility of young people in LLDCs?
- What policies, strategies, measures/actions should be implemented by government and involved stakeholders to ensure that all young people from LLDCs are connected and can have access to affordable and digitally accessible Information Communication and Technology (ICT) including equipment, products and services and they are skilled to guarantee a safe use of ICTs?

THEMATIC AREA 4: ENHANCING ADAPTIVE CAPACITY, STRENGTHENING RESILIENCE AND REDUCING VULNERABILITY TO CLIMATE CHANGE AND DISASTERS

- What measures /actions should be taken to ensure that more young people access climate finance.
- What measures should be taken to build youth green-skills and enhance their adaptive capacity to climate change.
- What measures should be put in place to enable young people in communities and grassroot organisations to take the lead in early warning systems so as to strengthen resilience.

THEMATIC AREA 5: MEANS OF IMPLEMENTATION

- How can young people be formally involved in the implementation, follow-up and monitoring of the Programme of Action?
