On 20 September, the United Nations Secretary-General is convening a Climate Ambition Summit to accelerate action. The Climate Ambition Summit will showcase leaders who are "first movers and doers" from government, business, finance, local authorities, and civil society who have credible actions, policies and plans to keep the 1.5°C degree goal of the Paris Agreement alive and deliver climate justice to those on the front lines of the climate crisis. By showcasing "first movers and doers" who are responding to the Secretary-General's call for accelerated climate action, the Summit champions leadership, solutions, and ambitious actions that are driving the transition to a low-carbon, equitable and climate-resilient global economy.
