This official side event at the 2025 High-Level Political Forum will introduce the work of the High-Level Expert Group (HLEG) on Beyond GDP, established by the UN Secretary-General in May 2025. The Expert Group is tasked with identifying a limited set of universally applicable and country-owned indicators that better reflect the multidimensional nature of sustainable development and well-being.

With SDG 17 under thematic review at this year's HLPF, this side event focuses on target 17.19: "developing measurements of sustainable development complementing GDP." There is **broad agreement on the need to move beyond GDP**—but the **urgent question now is what should be measured, and how**.

The event will provide insights on the HLEG's work, including its mandate and workplan, and seeks views and contributions from Member States and civil society on **the key** dimensions of progress needed for a globally relevant framework that truly measures what we value.

The event is organized by the Secretariat of the High-Level Expert Group on Beyond GDP, and the Permanent Missions of Spain, Morocco, and the Philippines. The session will take place on **Thursday**, **July 24 from 10-11:30am EDT** at **UN Headquarters in New York** in Conference Room 12 and will also be accessible **virtually**.
