

ENERGY COMPACT PREVIEW FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY

- As a Global Theme Champion for the energy transition, Germany is submitting a national Energy Compact to contribute positively to the SDGs and the Nationally Determined Contributions to achieve the Paris Agreement through national and international targets.
- Nationally, Germany aims to reach a 30% share of renewable energy in gross final energy consumption by 2030 as well as increasing the proportion of total electricity consumption covered by renewable energy sources to 65% by 2030 and achieving an overwhelmingly decarbonized power system in the 2030s.
- Internationally, Germany further aims to support its partner countries in reducing energy poverty, improving energy efficiency and developing and implementing transformative energy policies away from fossil fuels towards renewable energies within the framework of German international development cooperation. Areas of support will include, for example, the use of decentralized energy and innovative technologies, such as green hydrogen and PtX.
