1. Summary

- Antigua, Guatemala is in the department of Sacatepéquez, Guatemala at about 38.2 km from La Aurora International Airport in Guatemala City.
- The event will take place at the Training Center of the Spanish Cooperation (AECID) in Antigua Guatemala. The address of the Center is: 6a Avenida Norte, Antigua, Guatemala.
- During the event, simultaneous interpretation will be provided in English and Spanish.
- It is winter season in October in this region, temperatures might vary between 23°C (73,4°F) maximum and 14°C (57,2°F) minimum. It is also rainy during October.
- Guatemala (GMT-6) has the same time zone in all the country. For more information check the Time Zones section.
- Reservations of accommodation in hotels are the <u>sole responsibility of the</u> <u>participants</u>. <u>Hotels reservations should be made as soon as possible.</u>
- It is highly recommended to use the official transportation of the event and not taxis for transport between the airport and the venue. If taxis are used, be aware that most taxis accept international credit cards, take cash in Guatemalan Quetzal, and some accept dollars, but the eventual change will be in local currency.
- The use of insect repellent is recommended at all times.







2. General information about the Symposium

The Division for Sustainable Development Goals of UN DESA is conducting a number of initiatives and events designed to support the integrated implementation of SDG 6 (water) and SDG 7 (energy). One of these initiatives is the Global Sustainable Water and Energy Solutions Network created in 2018 (https://www.un.org/en/waterenergynetwork). The Network aims towards a world where there is an equitable and sustainable use and management of water and energy resources for all, in support of human prosperity, ecosystem integrity and climate change objectives, under the umbrella of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the Paris Agreement. UN DESA in cooperation with members of this Network has initiated a capacity development program based on a series of global symposiums designed to provide a global platform for all stakeholders to disseminate knowledge, exchange experiences and showcase best practices on integrated approaches that support sustainable water and energy solutions.

This global capacity development workshop is organized by UN DESA in cooperation with the Network and the governments of Guatemala and Spain and will be hosted by ASAZGUA in Antigua, Guatemala. The event will bring together multi-stakeholders to discuss and showcase existing initiatives and disseminate information on integrated sustainable consumption and production of water and energy actions supporting climate change objectives and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

3. Meeting Venue

The event will be held at the Training Center of the Spanish Cooperation (AECID) in Antigua, Guatemala. The address of the Center is: 6a Avenida Norte, Antigua, Guatemala.

4. Languages

Guatemala's official language is Spanish. Please, be aware that English is not a widely spoken language in the region.

During the event, simultaneous interpretation will be provided in English, and Spanish.

5. Weather

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Antigua Guatemala in October is 14°C (57.2°F). The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 23°C (73,4°F). The amount of rain in October is high with an average of 448mm (17.6in). It rains on average about 20 days during the month of October. You can expect very pleasant temperatures during the day.

6. Time Zones

<u>Guatemala</u>

Central Standard Time (CST), which is 6 hours behind Greenwich Mean Time (GMT-6). Guatemala has the same time zone in all regions of the country.

7. Visa

It is highly recommended that participants contact the embassy of Guatemala as soon as possible, depending on where you are planning to stay, to determine if you need a visa.










10. Transfer and Transportation from Airport to Antigua and from Antigua to the Airport

The arrival is at La Aurora International Airport in Guatemala City which is 38.2 km from downtown Antigua, Guatemala.

La Aurora International Airport to Antigua



It is highly recommended that participants travel from the airport to their hotels in Antigua and back using the official transportation company designated for this event, which is "GT Business & Travel" (https://gtbusinessandtravel.com/). Participants should make their reservations with GT Business & Travel as soon as possible, to ensure the availability of vehicles for transportation. Transportation from the airport to the hotels in Antigua and back is the sole responsibility of the participants. The average cost per trip is \$50.00 US dollars.




11. Electricity/ Voltage

As voltage can differ from country to country, you may need to use a voltage converter or transformer whilst in Guatemala.

Guatemala operates on a 120V supply voltage and 60Hz. For Guatemala there are two associated plug types, types A and B.

12. Currency exchange

The Guatemalan Quetzal (GTQ) is the official currency of Guatemala. 1 US\$ = 7.72 GTQ (rate on 09/09/2024 in https://www.banguat.gob.gt/tipo_cambio/). The exchange rate generally remains stable. However, it may fluctuate a few cents over the months. Therefore, it is recommended to consult the link shown above prior to your visit to Guatemala.

The currency exchange can be done at a nearby bank; however, it is essential that you bring your passport with you to make the exchange. In addition, you can use the automatic teller machines for currency exchange, or the exchange house located inside La Aurora International Airport.

13. Other Recommendations

- It is not recommended to use local taxis for transportation from the airport to the hotels and back. It is recommended to use the official transportation company for the event, as noted above. It is important to make your reservations as soon as possible, to ensure the availability of vehicles for transportation.
- Currency exchange can be done at a nearby bank; however, it is essential that
 you bring your passport with you in order to make the exchange. In addition, you
 can use the automatic teller machines for currency exchange, or the exchange
 house located inside La Aurora International Airport.
- International medical insurance is recommended in case of any eventuality.







- The use of insect repellent is recommended at all times.
- It is recommended to check vaccine requirements for Guatemala Central America.
- The best way to get around in Antigua, Guatemala is walking. However, the streets of Antigua Guatemala are cobblestone; therefore, it is recommended to wear comfortable shoes to get around.
- Hotel reservations should be made as soon as possible.
