Humanity is one big family. The 21st century is a time to unite under the auspices of the UN not only government organizations and the civil sector of all countries, but also business structures and individuals with innovative ideas for the common good.

Politicians, businessmen, scientists and enthusiasts can radically change this world through the implementation of Project Activities with the help of the UN. Project initiatives can have a positive impact on various sectors of the economy or improve the lives of people in specific difficult situations.

Chapter I. Sustainable development and financing for development

The Parties intend to create thematic clubs of businessmen from all over the world on the UN grounds who have a desire to invest their funds in charitable causes. These clubs can be implemented in the form:

- UN Space FORBS to finance various space projects;
- Political UN FORBES for financing and solving major problems in those countries of the world where government agencies cannot solve them;
 - other thematic or industry clubs.

Chapter II. International peace and security

The Parties recognize that in the third millennium the international legal principles of equal rights and equality of all states should prevail in the world community.

The Parties understand the need to amend the UN Charter and other documents in order to form new rules and procedures that limit the right of permanent members of the UN Security Council to participate in wars or military conflicts.

In the context of growing local military threats, the Parties will consider the possibility of:

1) creating several continental peacekeeping forces within the UN to form zones of responsibility of the states of the continents for security on their territories; 2) introduction in the UN Security Council of the decision-making principle "Consensus minus the voice of the conflicting party" in order to deter possible aggression from major powers; 3) increasing the number of Permanent Members of the UN Security Council with the inclusion of representatives from various regions of the planet in order to maintain a balance of interests of all countries.

Chapter III. Science, technology and innovation and digital cooperation

The international community must prevent possible forced migration and wars that may arise due to lack of water in certain regions of the planet.

In 2025, the UN Secretariat will launch the "Su Ana" (Mother of Water) project with the goal of uniting the efforts of major businessmen of the world in order, through their charitable activities, to create technical facilities - WATER PIPES from the world's oceans to all states of Central Asia and Africa that lack water resources."

The Parties support the introduction of Individual Project Activities at the UN site - private initiatives that can change the lives of people in a specific area or situation for the better.

With the support of the UN Secretariat, individuals from all over the world will begin to create private global projects.

The UN Secretariat will prepare proposals for the regular prompt collection of projects, their adequate financing, translation into all languages of the world, and technical implementation on a global scale through the creation of digital platforms or applications.

Chapter IV. Youth and future generations

The Parties welcome all possible and legal options for helping orphans. The Parties support the "Ainalayn" project to create a global digital platform under the control of the UN for the adoption of orphans. The UN Secretariat is instructed to begin creating a data bank of all orphans in the world with the involvement of competent government bodies of all countries to ensure the safety of children and find them parents with decent living conditions.

As an experiment, from 2025, the governments of UN member states are recommended to introduce a speed reading course into all school and student programs under the auspices of the UN Secretariat (Mergen project, author S.M. Seitimbetova, Kazakhstan). This educational project is designed to bring future generations of humanity to a new level of development by accelerating reading speed by 10-20-30-50 times and improving memorization skills.

Chapter V. Transforming global governance

The Parties support efforts aimed at helping endangered nations that do not have the opportunity to create their own state.

The Parties will study the possibilities of the Zher-Su project, the essence of which is the creation of new city-states for small nations on the verge of extinction, the status of which can be legalized by the UN.

The Parties call on philanthropic businessmen from all over the world to assist in acquiring islands in various parts of the planet and creating infrastructure on them.
